

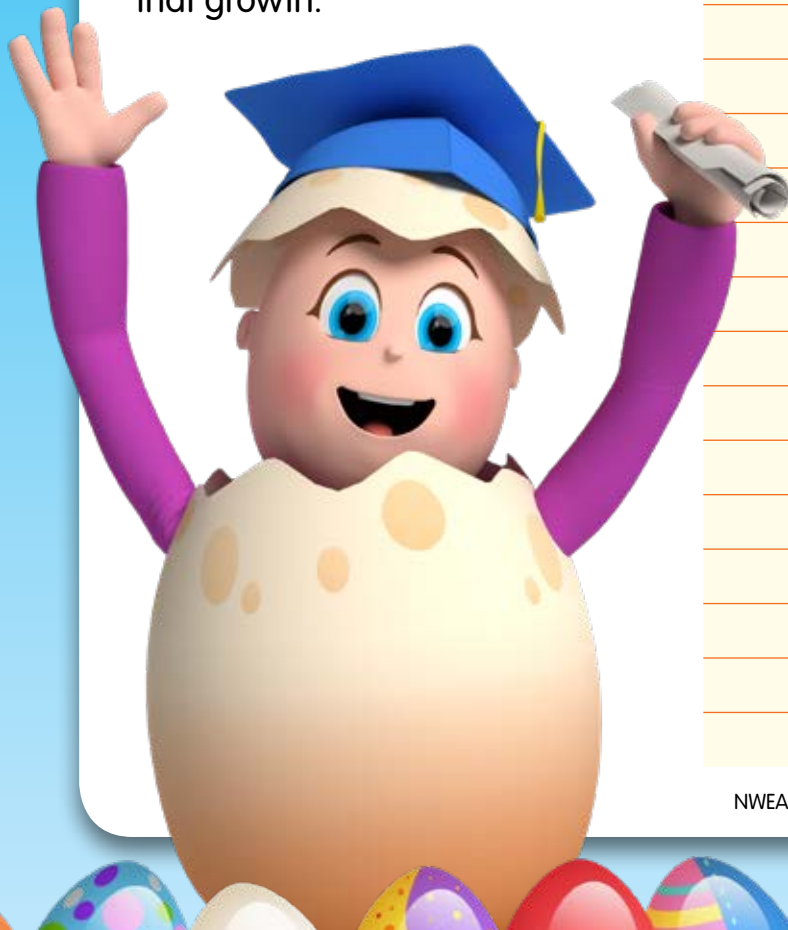
Reading Eggs, Reading Eggspress and NWEA®
